<p>PIU – a Danish programme to stimulate work placements abroad.</p>	<p><i>VET program in Denmark structured, as a so-called dual system where the student spends part of the time at a vocational college and a part of the time, working in a company, as an apprentice. So it is therefore possible for the student to have a part of his / her main course abroad.</i></p>	<p><i>The students get a possibility to discover another country, and experience about a foreign culture.</i></p> <p><i>The students get a better possibility to finish their education.</i></p> <p><i>The student will learn new working methods.
